Call for Proposals Award for Emerging Community Based Researcher



CBRCanada recognizes excellence in community-driven research

AWARD DESCRIPTION

The *Award for Emerging Community-Based Researcher* recognizes and celebrates an individual who embodies community-based research values in their work. This researcher has demonstrated excellence in working closely with a community(ies) in support of transformational community-driven, participatory, and action-oriented research that imagines and builds innovative solutions to pressing societal issues. The CBRCanada Award is intended to recognize the achievements of this promising community-based researcher and act to signify the importance of community-based research as a growing field of practice. CBRCanada is a membership-based national non-profit organization, and as such, awards are for members only (individual and [institutional members](#)).

The Award Recipient will receive a commemorative plaque and a \$1,000 cash prize to support their community-based research project(s). The Award Recipient will be announced in a press release, blog post on the CBRCanada website and in the CBRCanada newsletter, which will describe this individual's achievements and future aspirations in the community-based research field. Opportunities will also be available for the Award Recipient to publish a featured case study of community-based research excellence on the CBRCanada website and showcase their work in a CBRCanada webinar and online live discussion. The winner of this award will be recognized for their research achievements at the Gala Celebration that will be held online for all CBRCanada members in May 2021.



SELECTION CRITERIA

The award recipient should:

- Be an emerging community-based researcher (established within the last five years), and is open to community researchers, PhD students/candidates and PostDocs
- Have their research grounded in societal justice and community norms, needs, and assets
- Be able to showcase evidence of their commitment to community-based research excellence
- Have conducted research with a Canadian community(ies)
- Be employed/studying at a CBRCanada [member institution](#) OR registered individual member

NOMINATION PACKAGE

Nomination packages should include:

A) A one-pager (in plain language) or video (max 5-8 minutes), including the following:

- The name and affiliation of the person(s) filling out the application and their relationship to the nominee
- The nominee's name, affiliation and contact information (email, phone number and address)
- Description of the nominee's contributions to community-based research in response to the selection criteria

B) An endorsement by members of the community (e.g., via a letter of support or video). Please include one endorsement with a maximum of three community endorsements.

Nominations are due March 1, 2021 at 5pm ET. Award recipients will be announced April 1, 2021, and a Gala Ceremony will be held online to honour the Award Recipients in May 2021. Nominations will be evaluated by the CBRCanada Awards Subcommittee.
